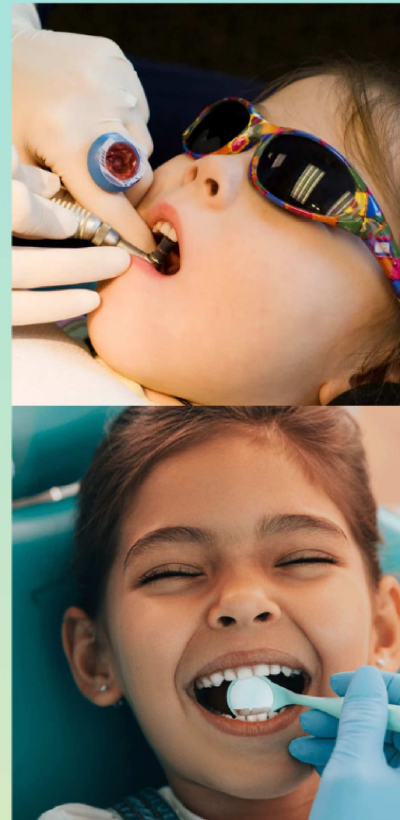
Promoting Positive Interactions with Young Dental Patients
